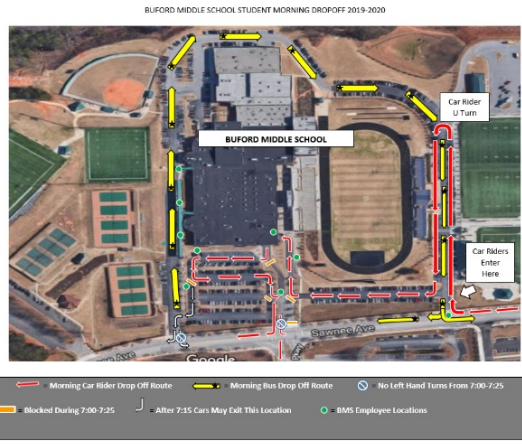
2019-2020 BUFORD MIDDLE DRESS CODE POLICY

The intent of this document is to provide a list of all **acceptable** articles of clothing, accessories, colors, styles, and guidelines. **Since it is impossible to list all items that are not acceptable, items not listed are considered unacceptable and will be considered a violation of our dress code.**

General Guidelines:

- Clothing must be free of rips, tears, holes, or frayed hems.
- Students should not wear black on black combinations.
- Undergarments and the midriff must be covered at all times. This includes, but is not limited to, when students are bending or reaching at the locker and sitting in the cafeteria or classroom. Undergarments should not be seen through the top layer of clothing as well around the neck, shoulders, or back.
